DID YOU KNOW?

June 17-18 || ACT to prevent heatstroke A hot car is one of the most dangerous places for a baby or a young child. Cars can heat up to 19 degrees in 10 minutes, and cracking a window will not provide enough air for a child stuck in a hot car. Parents and caregivers can use ACT to help keep children safe. Avoid heatstroke-related inju-ries by never leaving children alone in the car, and locking cars to prevent children from getting in. Create reminders, like a stuffed animal, in the car to remind you that you need to get a child out when you exit. Take action. If you see a child alone in a car, call 911 immediately. WORK ON YOUR SOUL

We are all as if in the womb, in gestation, in maturation to be born to eternal life. To be a betterperson, a better child of God; to live better the ideal to which Jesus calls us, **to manifest more and better every day the love** of God to all, to have more and more freedom every <u>day of the children of God</u>, from all attachment and bondage, from every vice, sin or slavery.

Life is not given to us every day just to waste or kill time, nor to walk or browse, nor to please our instincts, but to live more and better our divine vocation and our mission to be light of the world, to overflow with fruits of the Spirit, love, joy, peace, patience, goodness, meekness and self-control (Galatians 5:22).
