GLORIA EN LA CRUZ DE CRISTO

Filipenses 3,18. *Porque muchos andan como os he dicho muchas veces, y ahora os lo digo aun llorando, que **son enemigos de la cruz de Cristo, cuyo fin es perdición, cuyo dios es su apetito y cuya gloria***

está en su vergüenza, los cuales piensan sólo en las cosas terrenales.

El cristiano verdadero es el discípulo de Cristo, y para ser discípulo Jesús nos dice claramente las condiciones: *mis ovejas reconocen mi voz, escuchan mi voz y me siguen. Déjate a ti mismo, toma tu cruz y sígueme.* **El que rechaza la cruz y no la acepta, no puede ser su discípulo;** por ello San Pablo les dice con lágrimas que algunos han desvirtuado a Cristo, acomodándolo a sus gustos e intereses, tergiversando la verdad, viviendo como enemigos de la cruz, y convirtiéndose así en enemigos de Cristo.

Tomando en cuenta esas condiciones que nos puso Cristo para seguirle debemos saber que **no podemos abrazar ni seguir a Cristo si no aceptamos nuestra cruz.** Cristo no vino a quitarnos la cruz de cada día, sino a darle sentido. Puedo aceptar mi condición humana frágil, con tendencias al pecado, limitada, enfermiza y mortal, porque Cristo asumió esta misma condición con esas mismas fragilidades, haciéndola valiosa, puesto que es el camino que puede llevarnos a la salvación eterna, si la vivimos como él nos enseñó, desde la aceptación y ofrecimiento a Dios.

Como dice San Pablo: *Ahora me alegro de poder sufrir por ustedes, y completo en mi carne lo que falta a los padecimientos de Cristo, para bien de su Cuerpo, que es la Iglesia. Col 1,24. En cuanto a mí, Dios me libre de gloriarme si no es en la cruz de nuestro Señor Jesucristo, ...Ga 6,14.*

Cuando estaba pidiendo a Dios liberarse de alguna mortificación que sufría, Dios le dijo: *Te basta*

*mi gracia, pues mi poder se perfecciona en la debilidad. Por tanto, muy gustosamente **me gloriaré más bien en mis debilidades, para que el poder de Cristo more en mí.** Por eso me complazco en las debilidades, en insultos, en privaciones, en persecuciones y en angustias por amor a Cristo; porque cuando soy débil, entonces soy fuerte. (2 Cor 12,9s).*

Hemos de reconocer que en la actualidad en esta cultura pagana y hedonista en la que somos adoctrinados constantemente por los medios de manipulación masiva **hemos perdido mucho el sentido de fe y obediencia a Dios, y con ello el sentido de pecado, de sacrificio y de eso que son valores fundamentales de la vida cristiana,** y que van inseparablemente unidos a la fe verdadera, que nos lleva al amor, vinculado siempre al sacrificio. **La cruz es ofrecimiento y entrega, sacrificio de amor a Dios y al prójimo. Rechazarla es rechazar a Cristo mismo, y aceptarla es aceptarlo a Él y manifestarle nuestro amor y fe que es obediencia y confianza.**

GLORY IN THE CROSS OF CHRIST

Philippians 3:18-19 –

*"For many walk, of whom I have told you often, and now tell you even with tears, that **they are enemies of the cross of Christ, whose end is destruction, whose god is their appe-***

tite, and whose glory is in their shame, who set their minds on earthly things."

A true Christian is a disciple of Christ, and Jesus clearly tells us the conditions for discipleship:

"My sheep recognize my voice, listen to my voice, and follow me." "Deny yourself, take up your cross, and follow me." Whoever rejects the cross and does not accept it cannot be His disciple.

That is why St. Paul, with tears, warns that some have distorted Christ, molding Him to their own desires and interests, twisting the truth, living as enemies of the cross, and thus becoming enemies of Christ.

Given the conditions Christ set for following Him, we must understand that **we cannot embrace or follow Christ if we do not accept our cross**. Christ did not come to take away our daily cross but to give it meaning. I can accept my fragile human condition, with tendencies toward sin, limitations, sickness, and mortality, because Christ assumed this very condition with all its weaknesses, making it valuable. It is the path that can lead us to eternal salvation if we live it as He taught us—through acceptance and offering to God.

As St. Paul says: **"Now I rejoice in my sufferings for you, and I fill up in my flesh what is lacking in the afflictions of Christ, for the sake of His body, which is the Church."** (Colossians 1:24). **"As for me, may I never boast except in the cross of our Lord Jesus Christ..."** (Galatians 6:14).

When Paul asked God to free him from some suffering, God replied: **"My grace is sufficient for**

you, for my power is made perfect in weakness." Therefore, Paul declared: **"I will rather boast in my weaknesses, so that the power of Christ may rest upon me. For the sake of Christ, I delight in weaknesses, in insults, in hardships, in persecutions, in difficulties. For when I am weak, then I am strong."** (2 Corinthians 12:9-10).

We must recognize that **in today's pagan and hedonistic culture**, where we are constantly indoctrinated by mass media manipulation, **we have largely lost the sense of faith and obedience to God**. As a result, we have lost the understanding of sin, sacrifice, and the fundamental values of Christian life—values that are inseparably linked to true faith, which leads us to love, a love always connected to sacrifice. **The cross is an offering and self-giving, a sacrifice of love for God and neighbor**; rejecting it means rejecting Christ Himself, while accepting it means **accepting Him, manifesting our love and faith, which is expressed in obedience and trust**.

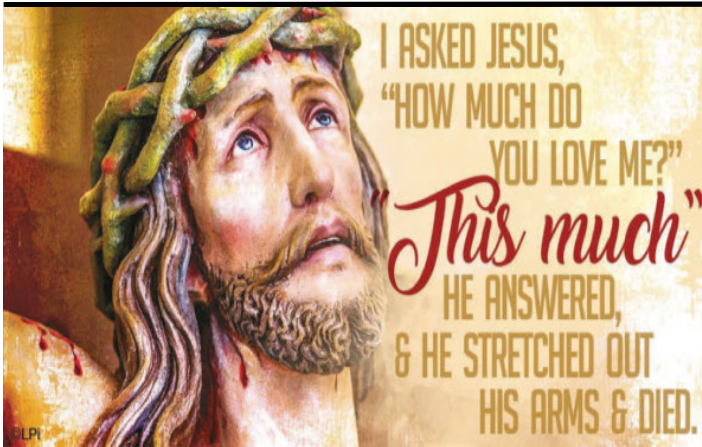

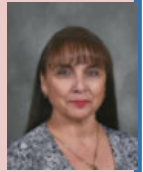

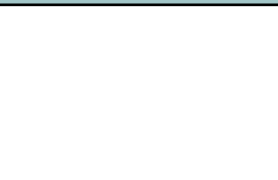
